Subject : Mock Trading for TradeX Version 3.0.9 and Trader (NEAT) version 3.0.8

The Exchange is pleased to announce the release of new version (3.0.9) of TradeX and version (3.0.8) for Trader (NEAT). For the benefit of members, a mock trading session will be conducted for the same on Sunday, January 24, 2010 from 10.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. **The new versions will become compulsory for all members using TradeX and Trader from Monday, January 25, 2010.** This would be available for all members connected through VSAT, Leased Line and Internet. All users are requested to download the new version which will be available from Saturday, January 23, 2010, 9.00 a.m. onwards.

Important: *Members are requested to take backup of the existing version before downloading the new version for mock session.*

Following features have been enabled on new TradeX v3.0.9

1. Limit Orders can be placed while in Square Off mode for Funds and Margin shortage
2. A pop message will be displayed in the Front End if the user has lost connection with the Exchange
3. Gross Quantity and Net Quantity can be viewed in the Net Position screen

Following feature has been enabled on new Trader v3.0.8

1. Limit Orders can be placed while in Square Off mode for Funds and Margin shortage

Members are advised to participate actively in the mock session to familiarise themselves with the features in the new version. Members are **required** to log-in to live environment after end of mock trading to check for connectivity and other log-in issues.

Members using CTCL facility need to change their Exchange version to 3.0.8 in order to participate in the mock trading session using their CTCL software. These users also need to check for connectivity and log-in issues after the mock.

Upon successful completion of the mock trading, TradeX v3.0.9 and Trader v3.0.8 will become active from Monday, January 25, 2010. Members, who have not downloaded and installed the new version of the software, will not be able to participate in the live trading sessions using older versions of TradeX and Trader, from Monday, January 25, 2010. CTCL users who have not changed their Exchange version to 3.0.8 will not be able to trade from Monday, January 25, 2010.

(A) Schedule for the Mock Trading session:

Date	: January 24, 2010
Login Allowed	: From 9.30 a.m. onwards
Session for non-global commodities	: 10:00 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.
Session for global commodities	: 10:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.
Trade modification time for non-global commodities	: 12:30 p.m. – 12:45 p.m.
Trade modification time for global commodities	: 1:00 p.m. – 1:15 p.m.
Confirmation of Migration to Version 3.0.9	: 3:30 p.m.
Re-login to LIVE time	: 4:00 p.m. – 4:30 p.m.

(B) Step-wise Instructions for Members to install TradeX v3.0.9 and Trader v3.0.8**Step 1: Backup of Client list**

Members are requested to take a backup of the existing client list by logging in the existing version and save the same in a secure location in their local drives.

Step 2: Uninstalling existing version of TradeX

- If previous version of TradeX was done using Magic installer, then go to Start → Programs → NCDEX
- Select Uninstall option to remove the software.

OR

- If previous version of TradeX was installed using Batch Process, then Go to Windows Control Panel and select the "Add/Remove Programs" option. (Start → Settings → Control Panel → Add/Remove Programs)
- From the list of existing programs, select "TradeX-NCDEX Trader Workstation".
- Click on the 'Change/Remove' button to uninstall the software. After successful completion of the process, the existing TradeX version should have been uninstalled from the system.

Step 3: Download of TradeX v3.0.9 and Trader v3.0.8

TradeX v3.0.9 is available for download in only "Magic-Installer" package.

Note: Java Run-time Environment (JRE V1.4 or above) is required to use the 'Magic-Installer' for installing TradeX.

- To find out if the system has JRE already, go to Start → Run and type 'cmd' to open an MS-DOS window.
- Type 'java -version' in the command prompt.
- If JRE is present in the system, the system shows the following text (given below example assumes JRE ver 1.6 installed) :

java version "1.6.0_13"

Java(TM) SE Runtime Environment (build 1.6.0_13-b03)
Java HotSpot(TM) Client VM (build 11.3-b02, mixed mode, sharing)

- If JRE is not present, the system will not accept the command. In this case, please download the latest JRE from the URL <http://www.java.com>

(a) To download TradeX from Extranet ISP Server:

- Log on to Extranet
- Go to Common\NCDEXDocuments\TradeX\Installer\TradeX_3.0.9 folder
- Download TradeX_3.0.9.exe file for Magic-Installer package

(b) To download TradeX from NCFE:

- Log on to NCFE
- Go to Member Downloads/Download Files/TradeX/Installer/TradeX_3.0.9 folder
- Download TradeX_3.0.9.exe file for Magic-Installer package

(c) To download Trader from Extranet ISP Server

- Log on to Extranet
- Go to Common\ NCDEXDocuments\TradeX\Installer\Trader_3.0.8 folder
- Download Trader_3.0.8.zip file

(d) To download Trader from NCFE:

- Log on to NCFE
- Go to Member Downloads/Download Files/TradeX/Installer/Trader_3.0.8 folder
- Download Trader_3.0.8.zip file

Step 4: Installation of TradeX v3.0.9 and Trader v3.0.8

Members should note that the new version of TradeX and Trader should be installed **only after close of market hours on Saturday, January 23, 2010**

(a) Installation of TradeX v3.0.9 using Magic-Installer

- Double-click the TradeX_3.0.9.exe file
- Follow on-screen instructions
- Installation is complete
- Login to TradeX and press <Ctrl+Space bar> to enter Local IP address and Relay number

(b) Installation of Trader v3.0.8

- Unzip the file Trader3.0.8.zip on Local trading terminal. It will contain the following files:
 - ncdex.bat
 - ncdextdr.3.0.8

- PKUNZIP
- ii. Open the folder and click on 'ncdex.bat'
- iii. Follow installation steps.
- iv. Installation is complete. Trader 3.0.8 is installed in Local Drive:\NCDEX
- v. Login to Trader and press <Ctrl+Space bar> to enter Local IP address and Relay number

(c) Import the Client List saved in Step 1

Step 5: Upload of contracts

On Saturday, January 23, 2010, after 4.30 p.m., please download "25012010.zip" from the Website (Downloads->Extranet Common Files->NCDEX Docs) or from Extranet ISP Server (Common->NCDEXDocuments)

(a) Uploading Contracts in TradeX

- i. Extract the contents of the zip file to the path C:\Program Files\TradeX TWS\Database for TradeX front-end.
- ii. Start TradeX front-end
- iii. Enter User id and password
- iv. Click on Upload button
- v. Select Local Mode and click Ok. This will update the contract, participant, warehouse location and delta contract details.

(b) Uploading Contracts in Trader

- i. Extract the contents of the zip file on C:\
- ii. Start Trader front-end
- iii. Enter User id and password
- iv. Click on Upload button
- v. This will update the contract, participant and warehouse location details
